COOPERATION

When we work together, we have to listen. This means we hear what someone says AND we think about it.

When we listen to someone, cooperation is easy.

A big part of cooperating is listening. We show we are listening by looking at someone, nodding, and double checking to make sure we understood.

Not only do we listen, we cooperate, but we understand what they say. This lets them know saying is important.



Cooperation is easy when we encourage each other. Next time you are working with someone, you can cheer them on or ask them questions about what they think.

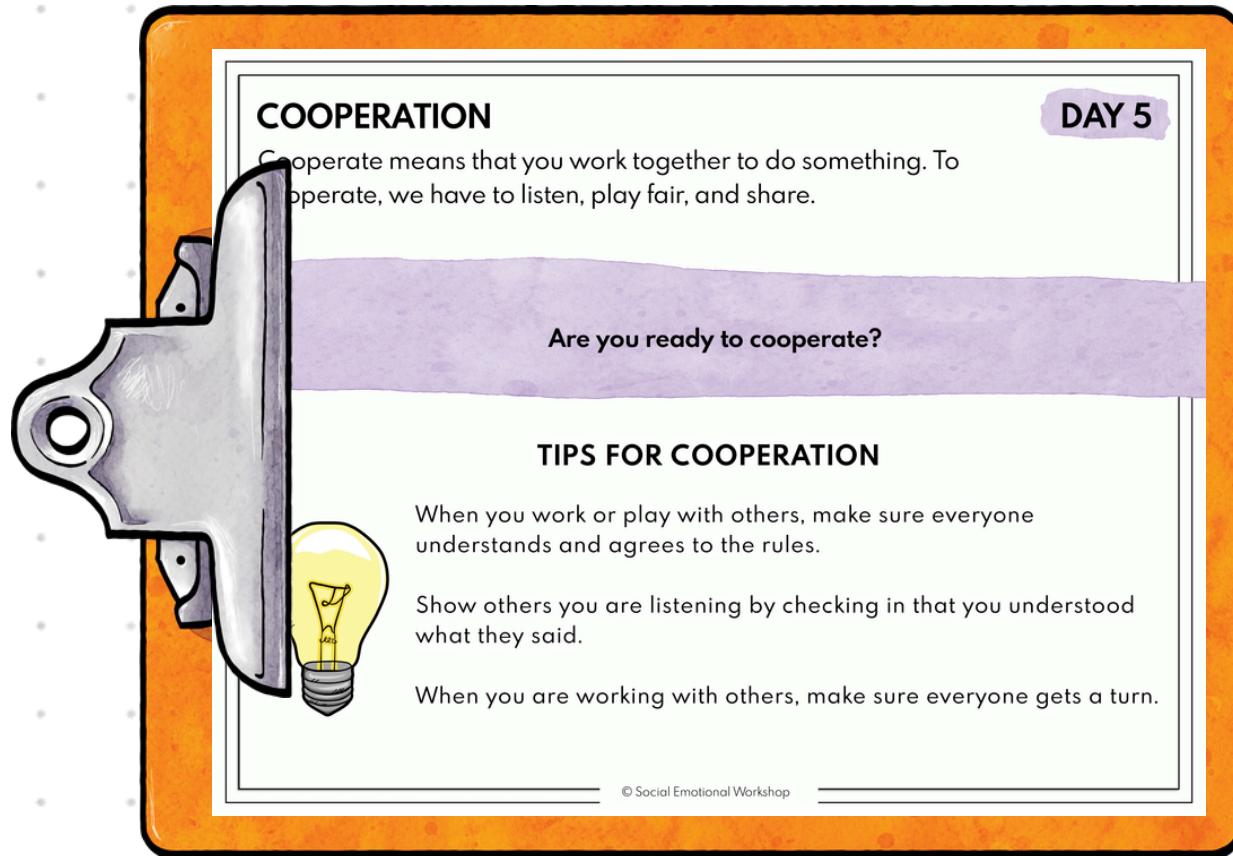

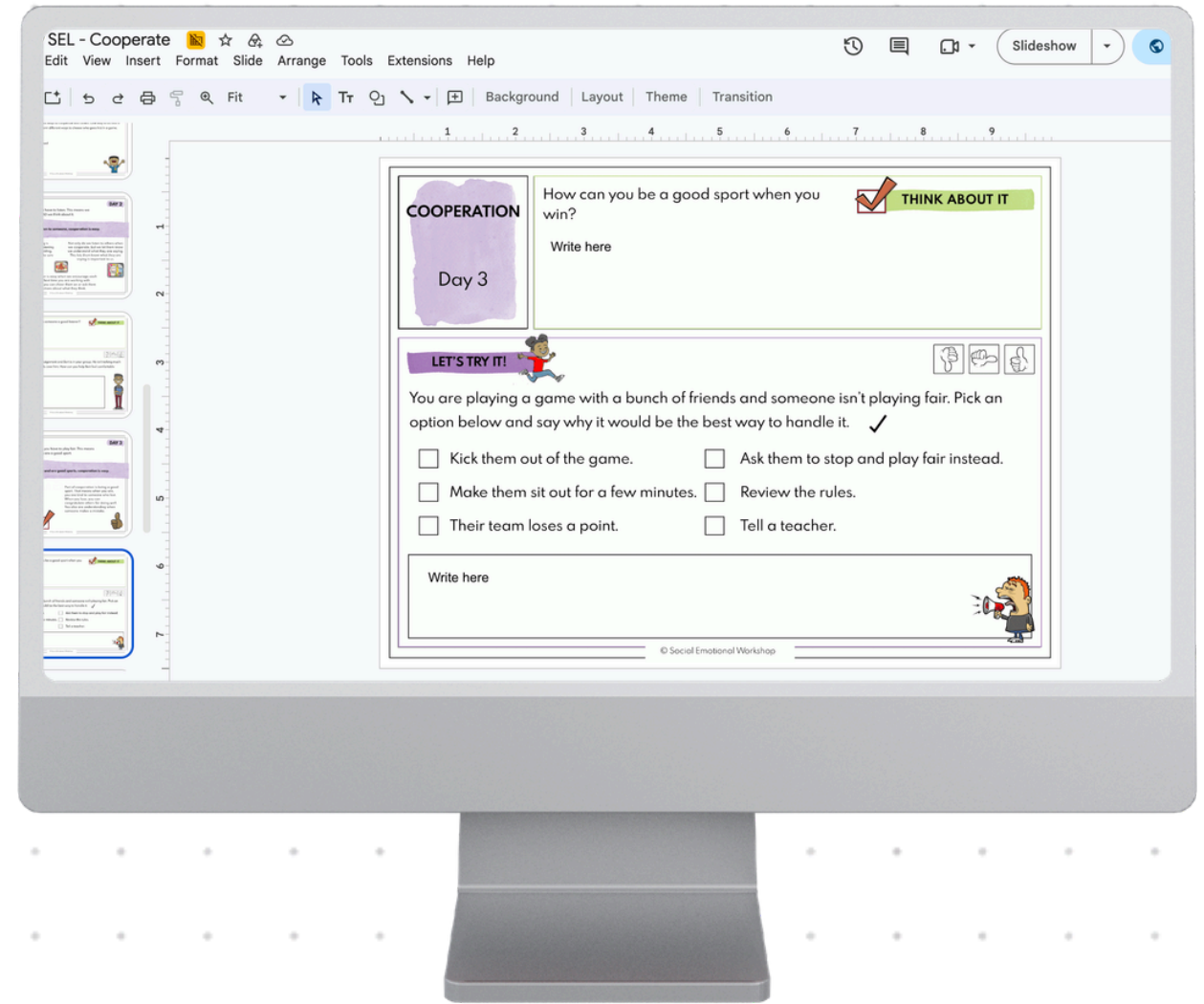

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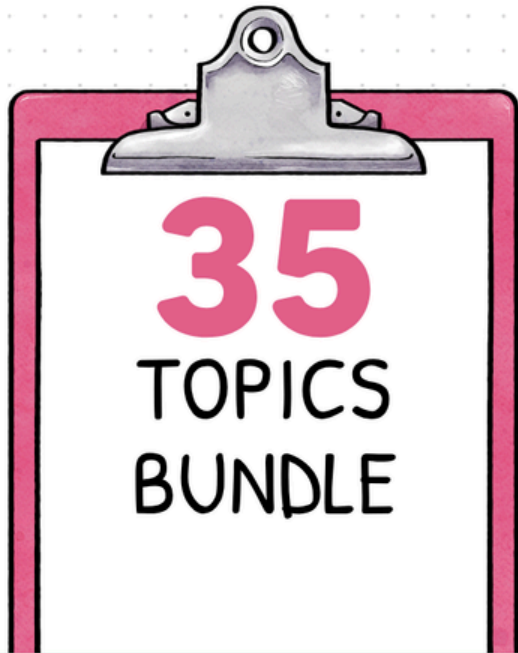
