everyone else.

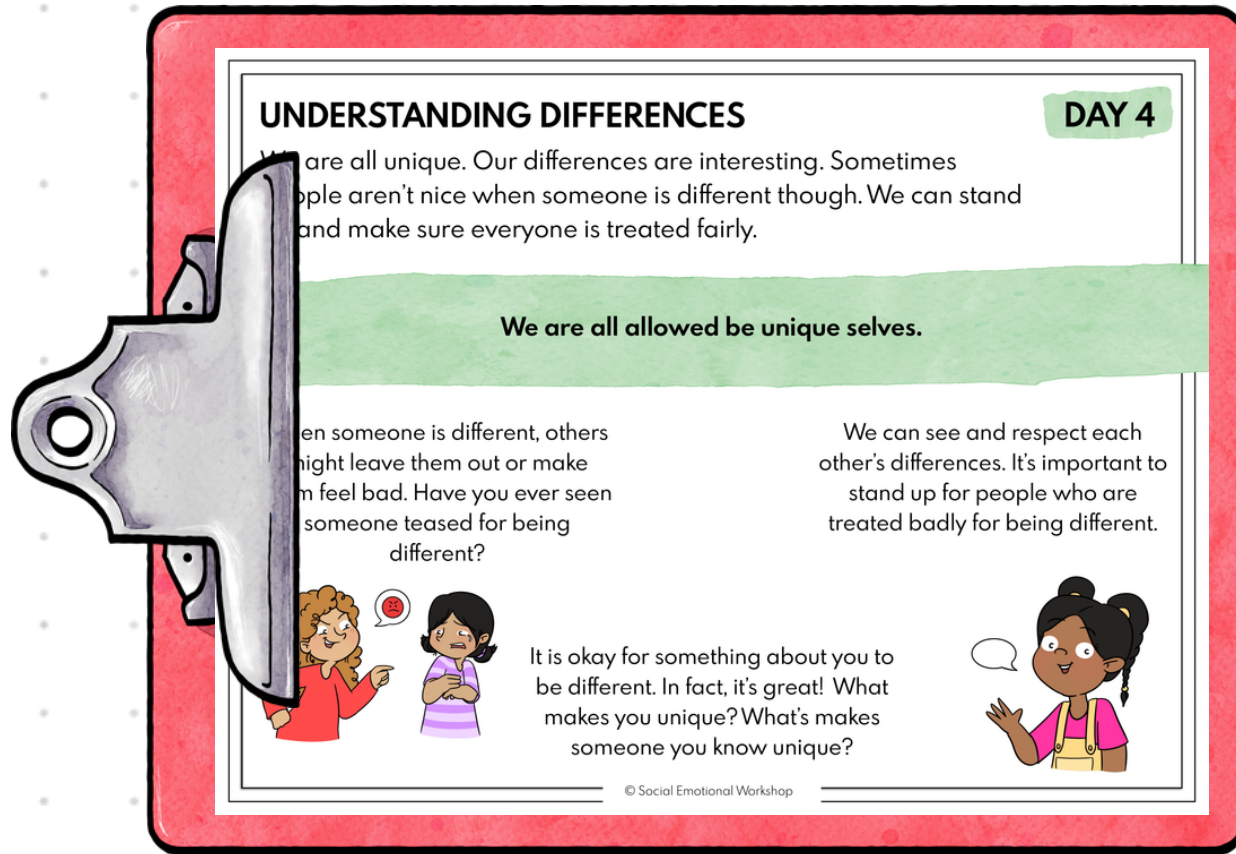

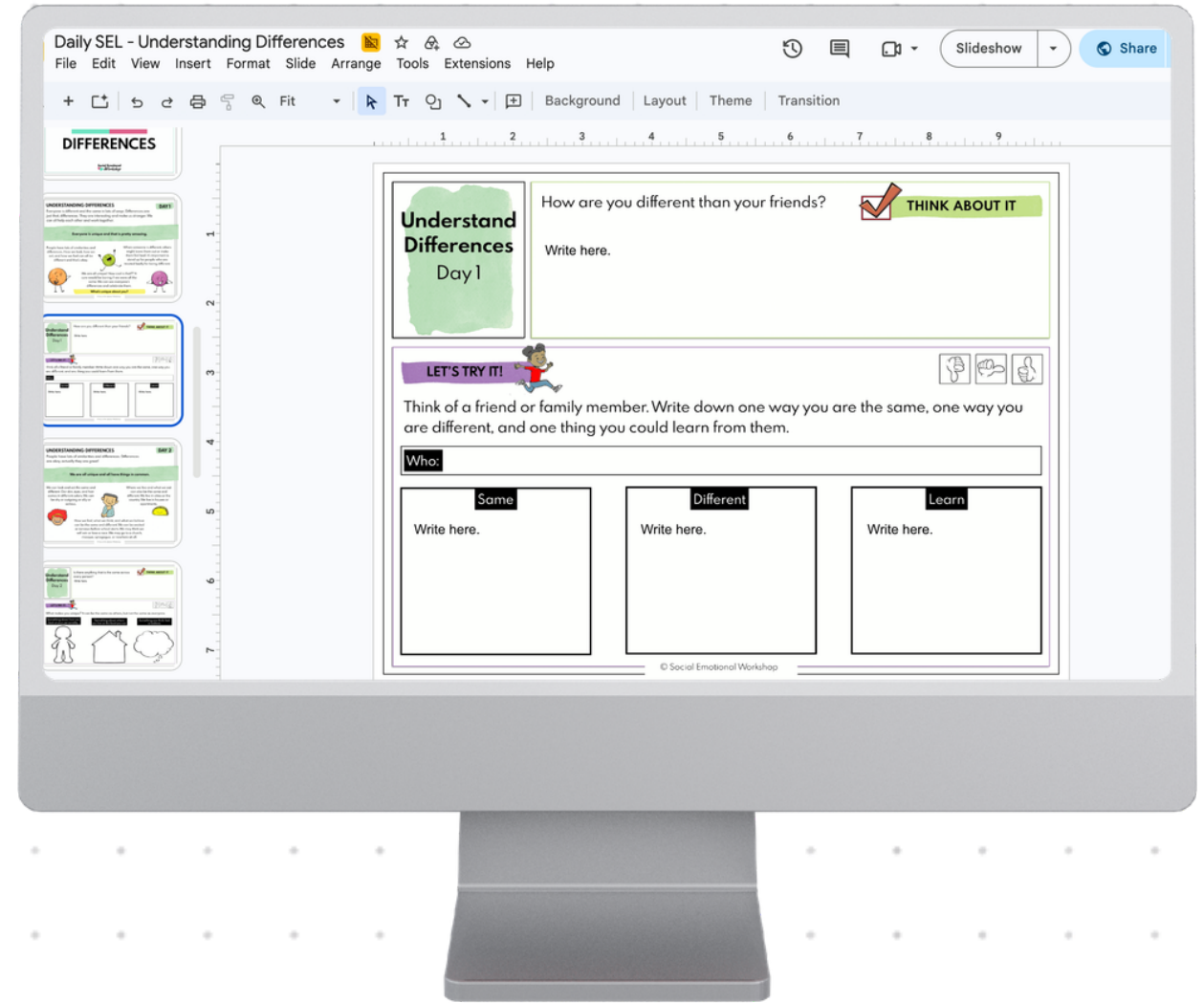

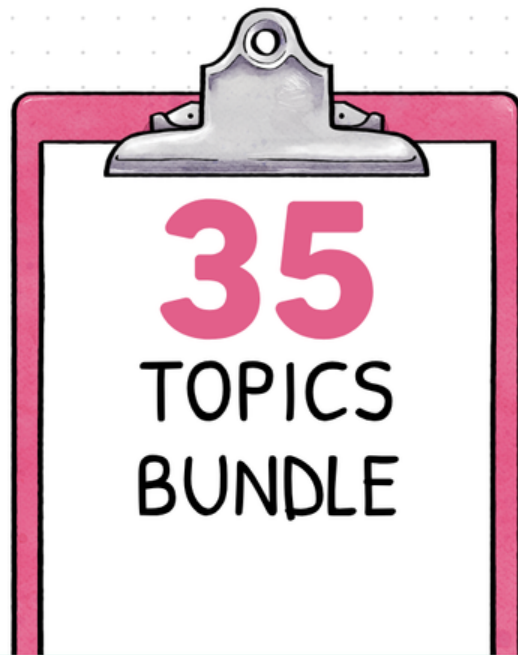
